WISELY TRUSTING GOD
Proverbs 3:5-6

INTRODUCTION:

- A. No matter what is happening around us or inside us, God is trustworthy!
"Trust in the Lord with all your heart; do not depend [only] on your own [or someone else's] understanding. Seek His will in all you do; and He will show you which path to take." Proverbs 3:5-6

I. GOD IS NUMBER ONE IN THE AREA OF TRUST

- A. The "on ramp" might be different for each of us but the "arriving at our destination" is very much the same.
- B. Solomon's wise words here are one of the greatest challenges in all of Scripture:
"Trust[ing] in the Lord with all your heart" Proverbs 3:5
- C. Trusting the Lord does have a very profound Eternal dimension.
"Everyone who [trustingly] calls on the name of the Lord will be saved." Romans 10:13
- D. It is also about the "***all***" of everyday.

II. NOT DEPENDING ON OUR UNDERSTANDING

- A. Solomon's second exhortation is about "***not depend[ing] on our own understanding [alone]."*** Proverbs 3:5
- B. It's a lifestyle that wisely declares that God's way is the best way.
"My purpose is to give them a rich and satisfying life." John 10:10

III. WE NEED TO SEEK HIS WILL IN ALL WE DO

- A. "***Seek the Kingdom of God above all else and live righteously and He will give you everything you need."*** Matthew 6:33
- B. Where in our life have we put up a "no trespassing" sign to God?

IV. FINALLY, HE WILL SHOW US WHICH PATH TO TAKE

- A. God makes good on all of His promises to us!
- B. God gives us direction, purpose and focused fulfillment.
