INTRODUCTION:

- A. Who we are as Christ-followers? We are "*new creations. The old has passed away. The new has come.*" 2 Corinthians 5:17
- B. "*He [Moses] kept right on going because he kept his eyes on the one who is invisible.*" Hebrews 11:27

I. OUR IDENTITY AS CHRISTIANS DEMONSTRATES OUR SPIRITUAL MATURITY.

- A. Maturity is marked by integrity.
"*...When he grew up....*" Hebrews 11:24

II. SECONDLY, IT DEFINES OUR RESPONSIBILITIES.

- A. God points us to His plan [His expectations] because we are His followers.
"*He chose to share the oppression of God's people instead of enjoying the fleeting pleasures of sin.*" Hebrews 11:25

III. KNOWING WE ARE GOD'S CHILDREN DIRECTS OUR PRIORITIES.

- A. Knowing Christ directs our priorities—what we do with our time, talent, treasure and touch.
- B. Moses' palace priorities?
"*He thought it was better to suffer for the sake of Christ than to win the treasures of Egypt....*" Hebrews 11:26

IV. IT ALSO DETERMINES OUR DESTINY.

- A. "*It was by faith that Moses left the land of Egypt, not fearing the king's anger. He kept right on going because he kept his eyes on the one who is invisible.*" Hebrews 11:27
- B. Faith gives us courage to leave our past behind ("*Moses left the land*").
- C. Faith gives us courage to walk into the future ("*He kept right on going*").
