- A. Faithfulness is about leaning in with integrity, especially in the small matters in life.

- B. Faithful people lean into the unselfish use of our talents.

Each one should use whatever gift you have received to serve others, faithfully...

— I Peter 4:10

- C. The faith-filled lean into their generosity in times of shortage.
 - "I, [Jesus] tell you, use your worldly resources to benefit others and make friends for eternity. In this way, your generosity stores up a reward for you in heaven...But if you are unfaithful with your worldly wealth, who will trust you with the true riches of heaven? You cannot serve both God and money." - Luke 16:9-14
