### INTRODUCTION:

A. We must choose and keep on choosing.

**"God blesses those who are humble for they will inherit the whole earth." – Matthew 5:5**

B. Humility or meekness is not weakness; it is a choice.

C. We do fall short, falter and fail in life and faith: "To err is human..."

- "I am not God."

D. What brings substantive change to our life?

### I. HUMILITY HAS ALWAYS BEEN GOD'S WAY FOR HUMANITY

A. What is humility?

- It means being mild mannered. But it also means....

B. Humility is strength under control (like the life of Jesus).

***He is your example, and you must follow in His steps. He never sinned...***

***He did not retaliate when He was insulted nor threaten revenge when He suffered. He (humbly) left His case in the hands of God, who judges fairly.*** – I Peter 2:21-23

- Moses was very humble, too

***...more humble than any other person on the earth.*** – Numbers 12:3

C. A humble person knows that God is holy, and they are not.

***"God, your God, is the God of all gods, He's the master of all masters, a God immense and powerful and awesome."*** – Deuteronomy 10:17 (The Message)

- God is to be worshiped, not us.
- We want other people to be awed by us.

D. Humble people are people who understand who they are and whose they are in Christ.

- Not less than human, not superhuman, but fully human.

***"My purpose [in coming to earth] is to give them a rich and satisfying [meaningful] life."***

– John 10:10

***Everyone who believes that Jesus is the Christ is a child of God.***

– I John 5:1

### II. GOD CHOOSES US SO WE CAN CHOOSE HIM.
