

- D. **Connecting with God's presence.** (See John 14:16-17) When Jesus told the disciples that He would send "another," He used the word that meant another of the same kind. The counselor would be like Jesus Himself. In what ways is the Holy Spirit like Jesus?
- E. **Teaching us to know God.** (See John 14:25-26). How is the Holy Spirit our "Advocate"? In what ways does the Spirit help you in your walk with Christ?
- F. **Walking by Faith** (See Romans 15:13) What hope comes from the truths we have discussed thus far? Why is hope a good word to link these promises of God together?

Application of the Scriptures:

- A. How might reminding yourself that the same Spirit that raised Jesus from the dead dwells in you, change the way you approach your faith?
- B. How might relying on the Spirit's power help you overcome feelings of inadequacy? What is one area of your life in which you need to rely on the power of the Spirit to help you glorify God?
