INTRODUCTION:

A. We are better together than we are alone!

For you are a people holy to the Lord your God. The Lord your God has chosen you out of all people on the face of the earth to be His people, His treasured possession.

B. A shared unity (Koinonia) that **"salts...and...lights"** the Church and the community.

C. **Seven SCC Core Values:**

1. Lost people matter to God and to us (Luke 5:30-32).

2. Becoming a fully devoted follower of Jesus Christ is normal/optimal (Ephesians 4:13 & 5:1-2).

3. The Church is a community of servants empowered and equipped for ministry – both inside the church and out in the community (I Corinthians 12).

5. Loving relationships should permeate every aspect of life as a community of faith (I Corinthians 13; John 13:34-35)
