11. Why is putting our ultimate fulfillment on other people bad for those we place it on?

12. What do you think about this phrase in the sermon, "Contentment comes not from me in a different set of circumstances, but Jesus in every circumstance?"
13. What's the area where I lack trust, what's that one thing I want to add to Jesus?
