- A. If we base our identity on our attainments, circumstances, outward life, and feelings we are missing a huge part of what God intends. This is called "the flesh" (Greek: sarx) usually translated "sinful nature". It is relying on our natural selves.

II. WHAT HAPPENS WHEN WE BECOME ______ OF JESUS?

Jesus said: "The Spirit gives life; the flesh counts for nothing." — John 6:63

We have stopped evaluating others from a human (flesh) point of view... This means that anyone who belongs to Christ has become a new person. The old life is gone; a new life has begun!


