INTRODUCTION:

- A. I want peace of mind...don't you?
- B. We want it but very rarely are experiencing it.
- C. Jesus wants us to have peace.

"All who love me will do what I say. My Father will love them, and we will come and make our <u>home</u> with each of them...But when the Father sends the Advocate as my representative – that is, the Holy Spirit — he will teach you everything and will remind you of everything I have told you. I am leaving you a gift — peace of mind and heart. And the peace I give is a gift the world cannot give. So don't be troubled or afraid."

John 14:23, 26-27

I. WE HAVE TO MAKE PEACE WITH WHAT WE CANNOT CHANGE

- A. We worry, feel guilty and get mad about what we cannot change...about it, them and us. Such feeling don't change anything and surely do not give us peace.
 - The key, with God's help, is to change all we can change and accept we can't.
- B. Being at peace is something "the Holy Spirit will teach you (me)." John 14:26

 I have learned to be satisfied with the things I have and with everything that happens.

 I know how to live when I am poor, and I know how to live when I have plenty. I have learned the secret of being happy at any time in everything that happens...I can do all things through Christ, because He gives me strength.

 Philippians 4:11-13
 - What gives us peace most is God's <u>presence</u>...more than His answer.
- C. The Serenity Prayer: "God grant me the serenity (peace) to accept the things I cannot change, the courage to change the things I can, and the wisdom to know the difference."

II. PEACE IS EXPERIENCED WHEN WE TRUST GOD'S PEACE

You will keep in perfect peace all who <u>trust</u> in you, all whose <u>thoughts</u> <u>are fixed</u> on you.

Trust in the Lord always, for the Lord God is the eternal rock. Isaiah 26:3-4

B. Peace is <u>elusive</u> because life is never problem-free. Problems get our thoughts moving in the wrong direction:

<u>Don't</u> worry...pray...tell God what you need...<u>Then</u> you will experience God's peace... His peace will <u>guard</u> your hearts and minds as you live in Christ Jesus. Philippians 4:6-7

III. PEACE IS DISCOVERED THROUGH GOD'S LOVING DIRECTION

- A. Have you noticed, at times, how you're at war with God? Who is going to be in control?
 - "...the more I called to him the farther he moved from me...I taught Israel how to walk, leading him along by the hand...I led...with ropes of kindness and love... I myself...feed him...They call me the Most High, but they don't truly honor me."

Hosea 11:2-4,7

- **B**. God desires our obedience but will not demand it.
 - Where in your life are you having trouble embracing God's direction?
