INTRODUCTION:

- A. God is the source of our hope and we can trust him.
 - God makes a promise to us.

And this same God who takes care of me will supply <u>all</u> your needs from his glorious riches, which <u>have been given</u> to us in Christ Jesus. Philippians 4:19

• God **points** out our need to respond. (Matthew 9:9)

As Jesus was walking along, he saw a man named Matthew sitting at his tax collector's booth. "Follow me and be my disciple,"...So Matthew got up and followed Jesus.

• God details the **process**. (I Peter 1:7).

These trials will show that your faith is genuine. It is being tested...

I. THE PRESSURES OF LIFE TEST OUR HOPE

- A. How do you handle stress and fear?
 - Avoid it. Complain about it. Anesthetize it. Displace it.
- B. Do we go to God first or ????
 - He is ready and wanting for us to ask for his help.

Then call on me when you are in trouble, and I will rescue you, and you will give me glory.

Psalm 50:15

• We dig our own hole and then we ask God to bless it.

II. PEOPLE TEST OUR HOPE

- A. How do we handle disappointment?
- B. The problem is not "other people" but what we expect of people.
 - We need to be able to trust people (limited, inconsistent, absent)
 - We trust them instead of trusting **God** (unlimited, consistent, always there).

My old self (which would have unrealistic expectations of others) has been crucified with Christ. It is no longer I who live, but Christ lives in me. So, I live in this earthly body by <u>trusting</u> in the <u>Son of God</u>...

Galatians 2:20

III. A THIRD TEST IS THE PRIORITY TEST

A. What will be our top priority?

"So, don't worry about these things, saying, 'What will we eat? What will we drink? What will we wear?' These things <u>dominate</u> the <u>thoughts</u> of unbelievers, but your heavenly Father already knows <u>all</u> of your <u>needs</u>. Seek the Kingdom of God above <u>all</u> else, and live righteously and he will <u>give</u> you <u>everything</u> you need." Matthew 6:31-33

- B. Many (often good things) are **competing** for the top spot in our lives.
- C. Faith and life are about three priorities:
 - What do you think about most?
