### INTRODUCTION:

- A. It is true that we need a faith that really works in today's world...in our daily lives.
- B. Jesus' knows this need of ours and He is not surprised by anything. That's why He says:

"Anyone who <u>listens</u> to my teaching and <u>follows</u> it is wise, like a person who builds a house on solid rock. Though the rain comes in torrents and the floodwaters rise and the winds beat against that house, it <u>won't</u> collapse because it is <u>built</u> on bedrock. But anyone who <u>hears</u> my teaching and <u>doesn't obey</u> it is foolish, like a person who builds a house on sand. When the rain and floods come and the winds beat against that house, it will collapse with a mighty crash."
