Getting Started:

Searching the Scriptures:

- D. James 1:23-25 compares the Word of God to a mirror. What does it mean to "look intently" into the perfect law? How can this habit of self-reflection contribute to a faithful foundation?

E. Both passages emphasize the importance of hearing and obeying God's Word. How can actively engaging with Scripture contribute to building and maintaining our faith walk?

F. How has God's word been a personal gift to you?

A. What practical steps can you take to ensure that your foundation of faith remains strong and faithful in the midst of difficulties?
