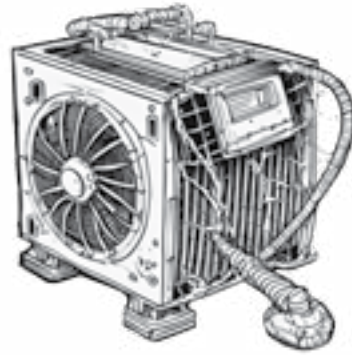


# Warming Up Our Vision

## ADDRESSING OUR HVAC NEEDS



**SCC is a vibrant family of believers growing in faith and dependence on God.** For decades our church has ministered in our community and around the world. Through all our efforts we constantly encourage people to join us as we become more like Jesus.

It has been exciting to watch the Lord bless our church. In this last year, we've watched the Lord add to our numbers. Led by the Spirit, dedicated staff, and our amazing team of leaders, we've expanded opportunities to minister to and serve people at every age and stage of life.

While seeing these amazing things God is doing, we've become aware of a pressing issue that must be addressed.

We can't say it enough, the people of SCC have generously responded to our needs in the past – addressing sound system deficiencies, the beatification of our campus. At the time, those were pressing issues. Now, we are faced with a very practical need.

In Genesis 2, God calls us to care for and cultivate all He has given us. At SCC, we've been entrusted with a campus that has served the needs of so many over the years. To continue serving the Lord, we must address our aging, inefficient, and ailing HVAC systems both in the Sanctuary Building and Fellowship Center.

## NEW HVAC SYSTEM

### *Our Need*

- Our existing HVAC system is comprised of fourteen units – two in the Fellowship Center and twelve in the Sanctuary Building.
- Currently only one of the units is working in the Fellowship Center. In the Sanctuary Building, only five of the twelve are functioning.
- Those in the Sanctuary Building are more than thirty years old and parts are no longer available to fix the ailing and inefficient units. Additionally, due to the age of the systems, operating costs are expensive and significantly less energy efficient than new ones.
- We want to avoid any interruptions in worship services or ministry activities because of failed HVAC systems.
- Your Session believes steps are needed now to assure this will not happen.
- To address this pressing demand, we have a plan.

### *The Plan*

While we are confident of the need, we recognize \$165,000 is a significant amount. This is why we are committed to move forward at the pace set through your generous gifts. We will begin with the Fellowship Center and move down the list in the order of priority.

- The initial amount needed to order the HVAC unit for the Fellowship Center is \$32,000.



- The next goal will be to fund the remaining amount for the unit.
- We will move on to purchasing and installing the fans in the Fellowship Center.
- This will lead us to raising the final amount for the Sanctuary Building HVAC units.
- We want to tackle this challenge now because the cost of equipment and labor have the potential of increasing substantially in the near future.

### *The Campaign*

To address this need, we are initiating the **Warming Up Our Vision** campaign. As you have read, our aim is to raise the funds for our pressing HVAC issues.

After looking at the bids and crunching the numbers, your Session is recommending a goal of \$165,000. We know achieving this amount will require an extra effort on everyone's part. Yet, having watched what God is currently doing at SCC, we are confident we can do this!

To ensure we reach our objective, it will require the participation of all the SCC family. The Session is asking we all take time to prayerfully consider what part "I" am to play in God's ongoing plan for Sequim Community Church.

- Perhaps the Lord is putting it on your heart to give a special gift of \$32,000 to start the process of ordering the HVAC unit for the Fellowship Center.
- Maybe a couple of you will feel led to join forces and provide a special gift for fans.
