Psalm 8

Derived from a sermon on July 6, 2025 by Eli Webb

Getting Started:

Has observing or experiencing something in creation ever made you feel small? If so, share your experience with the group.

Searching the Scriptures:

1. How does the body of the Psalm illustrate the bookends of verses 1 and 9? What stands out to you?
2. How is God's majesty revealed in creation?
3. Why do you think the psalmist contrasts what children and infants say with what foes and avengers say in verse 2?
4. What evidence do we have that God cares for us?

5. What do verses 4-6 mean? How are we lower than the angels but also crowned with glory and honor? What can we additionally learn about this from Hebrews 2:5-9?
6. Who gives human beings value (v. 5) and how does God display that value to us (vv. 6-8)?
7. How does knowing that God has granted mankind “honor and majesty” change the way you think about the people around you?

Applying the Scriptures:

- A. Which of God’s wonders do you especially appreciate?
- B. How has God specifically cared for you in a way that you felt loved and valued by Him?
