Getting Started:

Is it intimidating to think God knows everything about us, or is that idea comforting to you?

Searching the Scriptures:

1. What do we learn about God's involvement in our lives from Psalm 139:1-6?
2. How did David distinguish God's knowledge from our knowledge? Why was God's knowledge unattainable for David?
3. In light of such marvelous knowledge, what is David seeking in asking God to lay His hand on him (v. 5)?
4. Look at verses 13-16. What does it mean to be "fearfully and wonderfully made?" How do these verses confirm the linking of our identity to God as Creator? How does being fearfully and wonderfully made relate to being made in the image of God? (See Genesis 1:27)
