

Read John 1:6-14

5. What people are given the right to become children of God? What does it mean to be a child of God? What does it mean to receive him?

6. All people are children of God in the sense that he created us and we are His offspring (see Acts 17:28) How is this different than being “children of God— children born not of natural descent, nor of human decision or a husband’s will, but born of God” (v. 12-13)?

7. In verse 14, what specific aspects of God’s character are revealed through Jesus?

Have you received Jesus in the way John described in this passage? How is God prompting you to respond to him in light of this passage?

In what way is darkness a part of your life right now, and what will you do to invite the light of Jesus to pierce through this darkness?
