Getting Started:

What's one of the biggest decisions you've ever had to make in life?

Once you committed to a decision, what are some things that you were afraid of?
What difficulties did you have to face?

Searching the Scriptures:

Read Matthew 8:23-27

1. Why do you think Jesus and the disciples got into the boat in the first place?
2. What do you think of Jesus being asleep in the middle of the storm? Do you think that the disciples' fear was warranted?
3. Why were the disciples afraid? Why should they have been more confident?
4. Why do you think Jesus calmed the storm?
5. What was the result of going through the storm with Jesus and how did it impact the disciples?

Read Romans 1:16-17

6. Why might we be ashamed of the gospel at work, with our acquaintances, or with our family?

7. How does knowing that the gospel is “God’s power for salvation” give you courage to trust and put your faith in Jesus?

Application of the Scriptures:

Romans talks about a righteousness from God that is deeply associated with faith. To help understand this better. Write a sentence or two about what you **know** about God, what you are **convicted** and sure of, and what next **action** steps God may be asking you to do.
